



Pressure Reducing Valve

Rebate Application

Citrus Heights Water District (CHWD) offers rebates to customers who install a pressure reducing valve (PRV) on their service connection to reduce incoming water pressure. To qualify for the rebate, a CHWD representative must be permitted to inspect the property to verify installation of the PRV.

Installed after the water meter at homes or commercial buildings, PRVs automatically reduce the pressure from the water supply main to a pre-set level (i.e. generally 60 to 65 pounds per square inch) that is more suitable for efficient operation of irrigation systems, fixtures, and appliances. Higher water pressure results in higher energy and water heating costs, and can cause damage to plumbing pipes.

Please read the Rebate Program Requirements on the back of this application. All PRVs must be labeled as Lead-Free according to California State Law. Rebate applications require the signature of the property owner (if different than the applicant).

Indicate the manufacturer name and model of the PRV, the purchase price (excluding sales tax and labor) and the date of purchase.

Pressure Reducing Valve (PRV) Rebate Application: Rules & Requirements

1. Rebate application must be submitted within 1 year of purchase. **An original, dated sales receipt must have the PRV cost itemized (including make & model), and list the form of payment and name of vendor. Sales tax and labor are not rebated. For online purchases, a print out of the final invoice AND an original packing or delivery slip is required.**
2. All rebate applications must be signed by the legal property owner.
3. To qualify for a PRV rebate, the static water pressure on the customer's side of the water meter must be 80 pounds per square inch (psi) or greater.
4. The PRV should be from one of the following manufacturers: Wilkins, Zurn, Cash Acme, Watts or Apollo. Brands not listed here may be approved upon request.
5. There is a limit of one PRV rebate per service connection.
6. No rebate will exceed the purchase price of the PRV.
7. The rebated equipment must be installed at an existing Citrus Heights Water District (CHWD) service address prior to rebate request. New development is not eligible for rebates.
8. Rebates will be issued in the form of a check. The account must be in good standing to receive a rebate. Upon closing an account, any rebate credit balance will be mailed to the account holder. Allow four weeks from the date of the rebate approval for check processing.
9. Installation of any rebated device, appliance or fixture is the sole responsibility of the applicant, as is determination of the adequacy and compatibility of the existing plumbing system.
10. The applicant is solely responsible for the proper disposal of all materials associated with the installation of rebated fixtures and equipment and CHWD assumes no responsibility or liability. Please recycle materials.
11. CHWD does not guarantee materials or workmanship; acceptance of such is customer's responsibility.
12. CHWD assumes no responsibility or liability for any damage that may occur to an applicant's property as a result of participation in this program. Due to circumstances beyond its control, CHWD cannot guarantee that installation of rebated fixtures or measures will result in lower utility costs.
13. The IRS requires all rebate program participants receiving \$600 or more per calendar year in rebates to be issued an IRS Form 1099 unless exemptions apply. If you have received rebates from CHWD totaling \$600 or more in the current calendar year, you must submit a completed IRS W-9 form (see our website for a copy of this form) with your rebate application to receive a rebate.
14. CHWD may at any time, modify, suspend, or terminate this program without prior written notice.
15. A CHWD representative must be permitted to inspect the property to verify installation.
16. Incomplete or illegible applications will be denied.
